PARTY SAFETY V

Our Party Safety procedures are designed to ensure that the meals packed by enthusiastic participants at Feed the Funnel parties include only the ingredients necessary for the meals. That means no foreign objects or other undesirable contaminants! With that purpose in mind, please follow these Party Safety procedures as you prepare to pack meals.

J TABLES

All tables have been cleaned in advance of the party. If you notice anything that needs attention, please let us know.

√ HAIRNETS

Each person will wear a hairnet and, for those who need one, a beard net. Pony tail holders are also available. Please make sure the entirety of your hair is contained.

JEWELRY

Please remove all jewelry before you pack meals. This includes earrings, necklaces, watches, rings, and so on. If there's something that could fall off and end up in a meal, please put it in your pocket or another secure location. Note: Wedding bands without stones and medical devices may be worn.

✓ FOOD AND DRINKS

Please keep all food and drinks away from the Funnel area. These items do not pair well with the meals!

✓ THE FLOOR

Please do not use anything that comes in contact with the floor around the Funnel. The simple rule is "If it hits the floor, it stays on the floor." This includes cups, scoops, cheese packets, bags, and yes, the gloves you're wearing. If you need a replacement item, just let us know.

✓ FOOD ALLERGIES

Anyone with food allergies should exercise caution when determining whether or not to participate in a Feed the Funnel party. The following common allergens are used in our meals: Soy, Wheat, Dairy. For a complete list of ingredients used in the meals, please refer to the back of a meal bag.

J PHONES

Please refrain from touching your phone during the party. There will be plenty of time for photos after the party! If you do touch your phone during the party, please get a new pair of gloves.

J SI(KNESS

If you are or have recently been sick, or if someone around you appears to be unwell, please let us know.
